			<div>City requests</div> <div>●Dry out food waste ●Remove filth from disposable diapers ●Cut wood, bamboo, plastic hoses, etc. into 50cm or smaller pieces ●Plastic bottles are “Recyclable waste” ●Ash: moisten with water and put it into a strong bag. Write “灰(ash)” on the bag. Put no more than 10kg in one bag</div>

			<div>City requests</div> <div>●Never put a spray can or a gas canister ●Put cans and bottles in “Recyclable waste.” In case they cannot be cleaned, they are classified here ●Wrap dangerous things such as shards of glass or razor blades securely in paper</div>

			<div>City requests</div> <div>●Put cans, bottles, fluorescent lamps, batteries, mercury-type thermometers in the blue basket of the garbage station ●Put plastic bottles in the blue net bag of the garbage station ●Rinse out lightly the inside of cans, bottles, and plastic bottles after removing caps and labels ●Broken fluorescent lamps are “Non-burnable waste” ●Make sure that spray cans or gas canisters are empty to avoid explosion cases ●Take recyclable used paper (newspapers, magazines, cardboard) or old clothes to recycling stations or put out on your local community waste collection day</div>

			<div>City request</div> <div>●Garbage bigger than 18 liter square can (24cm×24cm×35cm) would be regarded as “Big refuse”</div>
