Tsuyama city is located in the north eastern part of Okayama Prefecture. Historically, the city developed and flourished as a castle town with Tsuyama Castle as its centre (which is now part of Kakuzan Park). Today the city plays a leading role in the northern part of the Prefecture making significant contributions to administration, economics, education and medical care.



As it is surrounded by mountains, the difference in temperature between daytime and \circ^{ℓ} nighttime is quite significant. The average temperature throughout a year is between 13 \sim 14°C and it is about 11 \sim 12°C in the northern part of the city. In summer, one will experience a heat wave with the temperature rising above 30°C. In winter, the temperature drops and the area is often covered in snow.





■The Map of the City Hall and its Surrounding Area




■The Plan of the City Hall (First Floor)
