1. Mother and Child Health Handbook (or Maternal and Child Health Handbook)

Upon notifying your pregnancy at Tsuyama City Health Promotion Division, you will receive a Mother and Child Health Handbook. Please keep it in a safe place as you will use it to record the results of your health checkups and to keep track of your child's growth. It also gives you information about various health services such as health checkups and vaccinations. Please note that you will need to obtain a Pregnancy Notification from your doctor first.

In the office, there are Mother and Child Health Handbooks available in versions of English, Chinese, Korean, Portuguese, Spanish, Thai, Indonesian, Tagalog, etc. Please enquire about non-Japanese versions at the time you file your pregnancy notification.

2. Prenatal checkup

You will also be given a Mother and Child Health Guidebook which

comes with 14 free consultation and checkup tickets (without them, you will be charged). You can use them at any medical institutions in Okayama Prefecture. Please make good use of them so that you can be in your best condition to have a safe labor.

* When your child was born in Japan, please report it to your home country as well. Detailed procedures must be enquired at the embassy or consulate of your home country.

* If you child will stay more than 60 days after birth in Japan, s/he has to obtain an alien registration certificate. (For the procedure, please go to Alien Registration Certificate on P.E.4)

2. Infant/toddler health checkup

Regular checkups are in place for children at the age of three to four months, 18 months and three years. You will be notified by post if you have children due for the upcoming checkups. They are free of charge. If you require an interpreter, please inform the City Hall Collaboration Promotion Division (0868-32-2032) at least 10 days before the date of the checkup.

You will be entitled to see a doctor twice for free of charge if

you bring the tickets that come with the Mother and Child Health Guide (have to be used in Okayama Prefecture). Please write down the same address you used for your alien registration on the tickets. They have to be used before your child turns one year old (valid until the day before your child's one year old birthday).

3. Vaccination

Please familiarize yourself with the vaccination program and receive the immunization appropriate for the age group. You will be notified by post for the upcoming vaccinations for your child. It is free of charge if you have it done when invited. However, if you immunize your child after the recommended period, you will be charged for the service.
